

Forcefield Flite Plus Harness

Company: Forcefield was launched in 2003 but their experience in body armour began back in 1987 when TPro started making armour for sports use, and they were one of the first companies to welcome the CE mark standards back in the early '90s. But what sets Forcefield apart is their belief that 'armour doesn't have to be plastic shell based to give you protection'.

First impressions: The only 'soft armour' suit here, it felt extremely comfortable from the get-go, and flexed with you when moving around and after a while you weren't really aware you had it on. The suit is made up of separate components joined together via an extremely strong, Velcro strapping system that does, in fairness, take some adjustment when you initially put the suit on for the first time, but once sorted, there's no need to ever do it again. The armour elements consist of back, chest and shoulder protectors for this particular model, although there is an

Adventure option that has the elbow/arm pads as well (see detail pic) to make a full suit. It's clear a lot of thought has gone into this product, as the overall look and feel scream quality and there's not a zip in sight!
